

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Members must belong to AAOHN, the national organization, to be eligible for membership in the state and local chapters. Annual membership dues are for January 1 through December 31. Local and state dues are in addition to national organization dues. A membership application and dues information can be found at www.aaohn.org or by calling 1-800-241-8014.

Categories of membership:

Active: Open to registered professional nurses who are currently employed in occupational and environmental health.

Affiliate: Open to registered professional nurses not eligible for active status, but interested in the field of occupational and environmental health; or others not eligible for active status, but practicing in the field of occupational and environmental health. (LVNs and LPs are eligible to join under this category.)

Student: Open to registered nurses enrolled as students in programs of study related to occupational and environmental health; or students in professional nursing programs who are interested in occupational and environmental health.

Retired: Open to members retired from occupational and environmental health. (Members in this category only are permitted to join a local chapter and not belong to the national and state organizations.)
